- Please check with your child for letters which have been sent home about our RSE curriculum. Copies can also be found on the website.

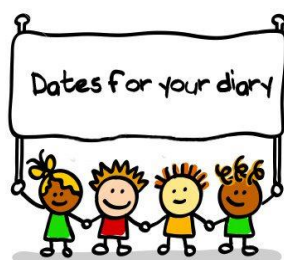
