## STEP 3

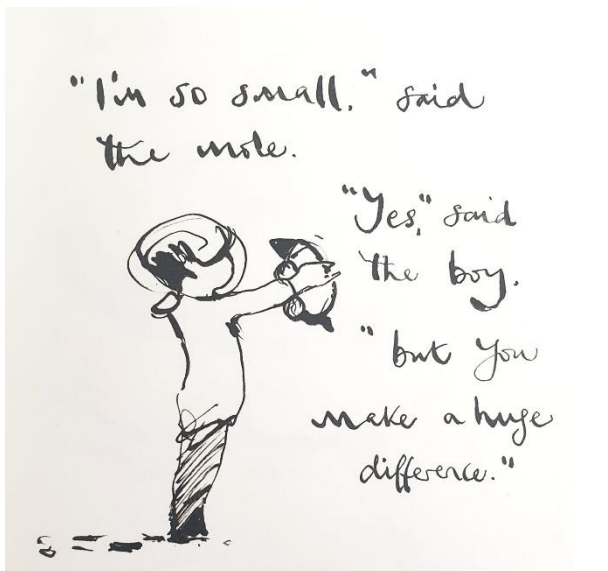
Put a frying pan over a medium heat and carefully wipe it with some oiled kitchen paper.
