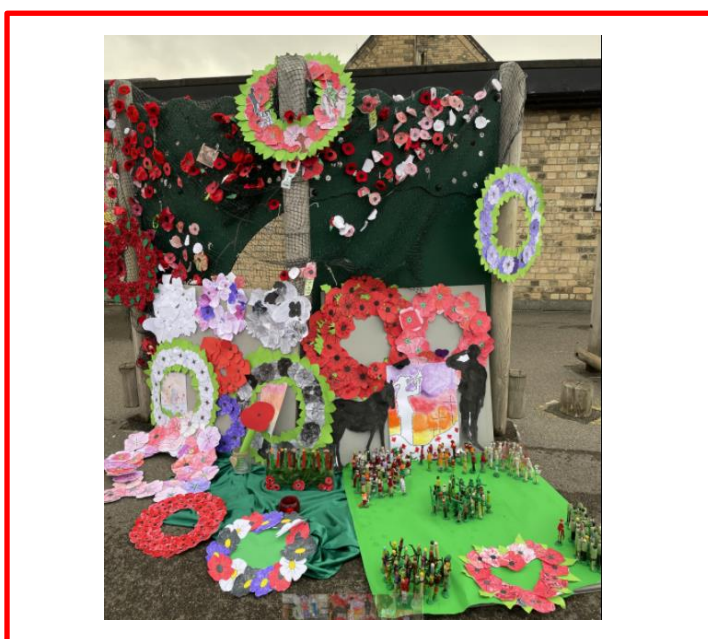


## PRAYER, POPPIES AND PEGS

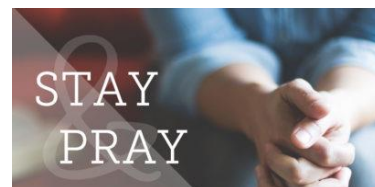
