Thank you to all of those who completed our online survey. We are delighted to say that 100% of those who replied believe that Endsleigh is a safe place with 98% saying their children feel safe at school and that safeguarding had the highest priority.

## SAFEGUARDING STAFF

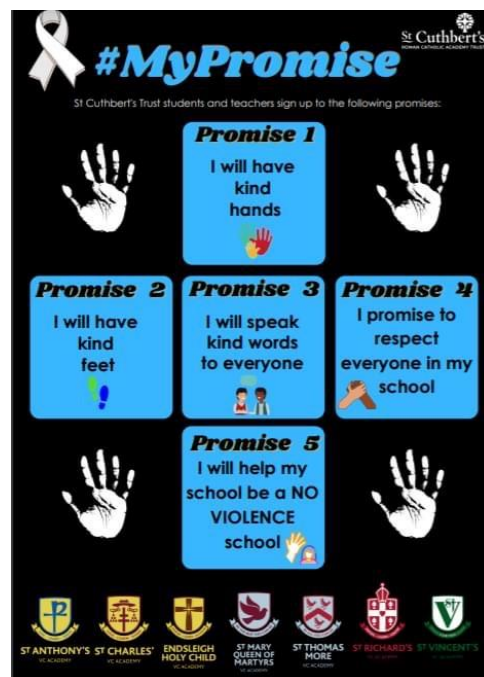
Currently, Mrs Bentley is the Designated Safeguarding Lead and Mr Guthrie is the Deputy Safeguarding Lead.
