The battle is on!! We are challenging our whole school to a Rockstars Battle from Sunday 23rd at 12pm - Thursday 27th May at 9am.

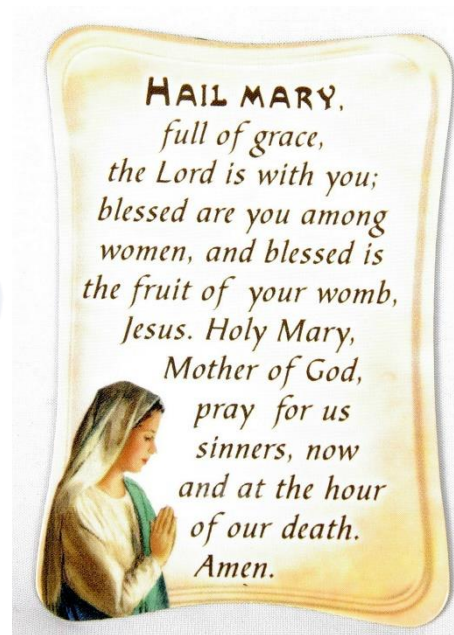
The winning class will earn themselves a dress as you like day so on the 28th May they can wear their own clothes.

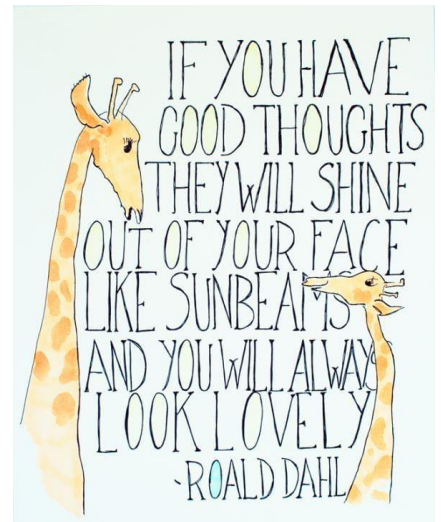
WONDERFUL SMC STUDENTS (AND MR CONWAY)
