### Lower Key Stage 2 trip

We had a fantastic time in York on Tuesday exploring the Jorvik Centre as well as its DIG site. The pupils travelled back in time as they went beneath the city's streets and took a tour of a Viking town, learning about the roles people held within their society as well as all about their daily lives. The pupils then participated in a workshop all about 'violence', discussing how Vikings would raid new lands. The pupils reenacted battles and got to use a range of equipment, from swords to axes, giant bow and arrows and shields.

The pupils then had the chance to become archaeologists as they explored the DIG site, unearthing artefacts from a range of time periods. It was an action packed day for all involved and the pupils' behaviour was exemplary.
