Dear Parents/Carers,

From all of us at Endsleigh, we wish you a very Happy New Year.

We hope that you are all well and have had a wonderful Christmas and we are looking forward to hearing all about it from the children tomorrow.

Due to the significant rise of Covid cases over the Christmas break, I am writing to remind you of some of the systems which we had in place and will continue to follow along with some changes.

Masks

We ask that ALL parents/carers, except those who are exempt from doing so, wear masks whilst on the playground and particularly if waiting at the gate at the beginning or end of the school day. As far as possible, we ask that you do try and maintain distancing.

Illness

As with last term, we ask that you do not send your child to school if they have any of the main Covid-19 symptoms: high temperature, persistent cough or loss/change to senses of smell or taste and that until they have received a negative PCR test, they do not return to school. However, we are also very much aware that the Omicron symptoms are very similar to a cold. If children have been in contact with someone who has tested positive, there is no requirement for them to self-isolate and they are expected to be in school as normal.
